


Don't judge people by the outside, it's what's on the inside that counts.



Argentina won the World Cup last year, making them third in World Cup wins. The World Cup was held in Qatar, where Argentina played France, who has one of the best forwards in the world, Kylian Mbappe. The score was 3-3 in overtime and Argentina won in shootouts 4-2. Here are some facts and figures about World Cup 2022:

- Best dribbler in FIFA 12,
- Most hat tricks in La Liga career,
- Most wins of the Ballon D'or,

He was born and raised in Rosario, Argentina and then moved to Spain when he was 13 and played for Barcelona.



# Super Space Suit

The SpaceX space suit costs around \$150 million today!



The SpaceX spacesuits are a one piece design, and much sleeker than Nasa's bulky suits and are made in Delaware. The new SpaceX spacesuit design is so slim that in 2018, the company's founder Elon Musk had to reassure concerned SpaceX followers after the suit was revealed. "It definitely works. You can jump in a vacuum chamber with it, and you

would be fine," he said.

Weighing at about 20 lbs, they are made from a type of fire resistant Kevlar and Nomex, just to make sure it was ready for humans they were tested in space before. A version flew on the Tesla driving dummy SpaceX launched towards Mars orbit. In 2018, and another spacesuit decked the dummy Ripley that flew aboard the uncrewed SpaceX Crew Dragon Demo-1 test flight to the space station in 2019.

Even though SpaceX designed for almost forty years a very maneuverable suit that makes moving around in space a bit easier, it is still nice to be able to wear flip-flops here on planet Earth.



## Weather Investigation

For this Experiment you will need a clear, plastic container (size of shoebox) red food coloring, ice cubes made with blue food coloring.

This is what you will have to do for the Experiment:

- 1. Let the water sit for one minute
- Fill the plastic container with two -thirds full with lukewarm water
- let the water sit for one minute
- 4. Place a blue ice cube at one end of the plastic container. Watch what happens.



**Explanation:** 

The cold blue water sinks, while the red and warm water rises. This happens because of convection. The blue water represents the cold air mass and the red water represents the warm, unstable air mass. A thunderstorm is caused by unstable air and convection plays an important part. A body of warm air is forced to rise by an approaching cold front therefore thunderstorm's form.



# The Fire Snake or Dragon's Tail By Emet

#### **IATTENTION!**

This experiment requires parental supervision!

Do this project outside!

For this experiment you're going to need lighter fluid, sand, a bowl, sugar and baking soda. Most of these materials can probably be found in your kitchen. Take a bowl and fill it most of the way with . Pack the edges with sand leaving a hole in the middle. Mix 40g of sugar and 10g of baking soda (or any 1:4 ratio) and put it in the middle. Soak the sand with lighter fluid. Take a match and ignite the lighter fluid (This should probably be done by an adult, depending on the child's age). Once you do that, it should

burn for about 30 minutes. In that time it will bubble, and over time create "the fire snake or dragon's tail". Sugar is C12H22O11, so it is a hydrocarbon fuel and baking soda helps accelerate the reaction. Since I used a small cup instead of a bowl, my snake looked like a bunch of little caterpillars. I noticed that it smelled like caramel while it was burning. Some people think it smells like cooking marshmallows.

9. What is your favorite part of the day?




